

Guess The Score Competition Rules

Overview

Welcome to the Canterbury Rugby Guess The Score Competition! Each week, participants will predict the scores of the Canterbury Men's and Canterbury Women's rugby games. There will be weekly prizes, as well as a grand prize at the end of the NPC Competition for all successful guesses during the entirety of this Competition.

Entry

1. This document contains the terms and conditions of entry ("these Terms") into the Whutuporo – Guess The Score competition ("Promotion"). Entry into this Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms.
2. The Promoter is Whutuporo Limited, 11 Picton Avenue, Addington, Christchurch.
3. The Promotion will be open from 8.30am 29th July 2024 and will continue until the starting time of the last match of the last Round of the 2024 NPC Season.
4. Entry into the Promotion is free.

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to all individuals.
2. Employees of Whutuporo Limited and their immediate family are ineligible to enter. "Immediate family" means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.

How to Enter

- Participants must submit their score predictions for both the Canterbury Men's and Canterbury Women's games where applicable by the kickoff time of the first game each week. Where only one game is being played then submitting their score prediction for that match by kickoff time for the game each week.
- Predictions must be submitted via the official competition website.
- Only one entry per person will be accepted.

Scoring System

- To be classified as a winner you must correctly pick the score of the NPC or the FPC game and as recorded on the official score sheet of the relevant competition.
- If the score does not match that as recorded on the official score sheet then it is deemed to be incorrect and not eligible for any prize.

Weekly Prizes

- Weekly prize will be awarded to the participant with the correct score each week.
- In the event of several correct scores, all correct participants will be recorded on the "Picker Wheel" via the www.pickerwheel.com website. The wheel will be spun once to identify the winner of the week.
- In the event of several correct scores, the promoter will film the draw and retain on file for confirmation purposes.

End of Competition Prize

- The participant with the highest number of correct score guesses at the end of the season will win the grand prize.
- In the event of a tie, the participants with the highest number of score guesses will be recorded on the “Picker Wheel” via the www.pickerwheel.com website. The wheel will be spun once to identify the winner of the week.
- In the event of a tie, the promoter will film the draw and retain on file for confirmation purposes.

Submission Deadlines

- All predictions must be submitted before the kickoff of the first game each week. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Participants are encouraged to submit predictions as early as possible.

Amendments and Cancellations

- Participants cannot amend their predictions once submitted.
- In the event of a game cancellation or rescheduling, participants will be notified.

Notification of Winners

- Weekly winners will be notified via email and the Whutuporo facebook page within 48 hours of the conclusion of the last game of the week.
- The end-of-season winner will be announced within 48 hours of the final game of the season.

Disputes and Appeals

- Any disputes or appeals must be submitted in writing within 24 hours of the winner announcement.
- The competition organizers will review all disputes and appeals, and their decision will be final.

Conduct and Fair Play

- Participants must play fairly and honestly.
- Any form of cheating or dishonest behavior will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.

Privacy and Data Protection

- Personal data collected during registration and participation will be used solely for the purposes of the competition and will be handled in accordance with applicable privacy laws.
